CLUB CONSTITUTION

1. TITLE

The club shall be called BURNHAM-ON-SEA HARRIERS

2. HEADQUARTERS

- (a) The meeting place is King Alfred's Sports Centre, Burnham Road, Highbridge, Somerset.
- (b) The contact will be the address of the Honorary Secretary at the time.

3. OBJECT

- (a) To promote athletics in accordance with the Laws and Rules of UKA.
- (b) To promote events under UKA Rules
- (c) To affiliate to County and National Bodies as may be necessary to achieve the aims of the club.
- (d) To encourage members to train, qualify and participate as Honorary Official in non-track and field events

4. MANAGEMENT

The management of the Club is vested in the committee consisting of a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman, Honorary Treasurer, Honorary Secretary, Captain, Vice Captain and at least three other members. The Committee has the power to fill any vacancy, which may, from time to time, occur. The committee will be elected at the AGM.

5. CLUB COLOURS

- (a) Club colours are a yellow vest with a vertical black stripe on front and back and the club logo on the front.
- (b) Club colours will be worn in any event promoted under UKA Rules.

6. MEMBERSHIP

- (a) A candidate must apply for Membership in writing on the form provided for that purpose.
- (b) The club will provide the following data to UKA for the purpose of individual registration with the governing body. – Full Name, Sex, Date of Birth, Postal Address and Competition/Volunteer Status. UKA will issue a Registration Number and Card to members.

7. SUBSCRIPTION

The club subscription is due Annually on 1 January. The rate to be decided at the AGM. The committee shall have the authority to expel any member whose subscription is six months in arrears. Details of any member expelled from the club will be sent to the Governing Body.

8. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

A General Meeting will be held, annually, during the month of January to receive the committee's report and financial statement, elect officers and committee and deal with any other matter specified on the agenda. The Honorary Secretary must give each member 21 days notice of the meeting. Members must give the Honorary Secretary 14 days notice, in writing, of any business they wish to be included on the agenda.
